

JDS Application in 2018 is now open for Mongolian young highly capable government officials and employees of private sector

The Ministry of Education, Culture, Science and Sports of Mongolia and Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) launched the application of The Project for Human Resource Development Scholarship by Japanese Grant Aid (JDS) 2018 on August 13, 2018. JDS application in 2018 is now open for Mongolian young highly capable government officials, also partly open for qualified employees of private sector. JDS Project is funded by the Government of Japan through official development assistance (ODA). Its objective is to provide Mongolian citizens working mainly in the public sector with opportunities for obtaining Master's Degree (2-year course) and Doctoral Degree (3-year course) at Japanese universities in order to support the human resource development of the Government of Mongolia, and eventually to extend and strengthen the bilateral relations between Japan and Mongolia. Totally 22 young government officials and employees of private companies, who are expected to play leadership role in Mongolia, will be selected for Japanese academic year 2018 (enrolment in September, 2019). The application deadline is October 19, 2018 for both Master's Course and Doctoral Course.

JDS Project has started in Mongolia since 2001 and has dispatched 320 JDS fellows to Japan up to now, and Doctoral Degree has just started since 2016. All study fields have been settled based on the Socio-Economic Development Strategy of the Government of Mongolia and Japan's assistance policy for Mongolia.

Information on study fields are attached herewith and shown in English as to keep technical terms precise.

JDS recruitment seminars at Mongolia-Japan Center are scheduled on 20th, 25th of August and 7th, 9th and 13th of September. Timing is from 6:30pm on weekdays and from 11:30am on weekends. It will also be held at several organizations as well.
